

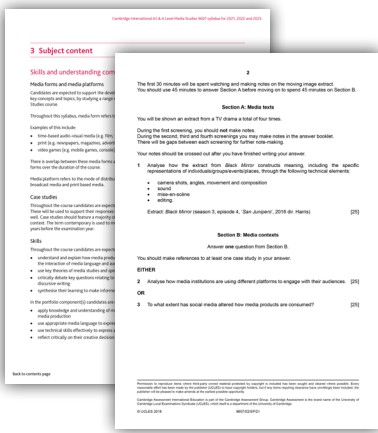

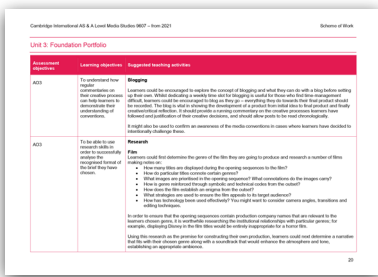

### Scheme of Work and Suggested resources

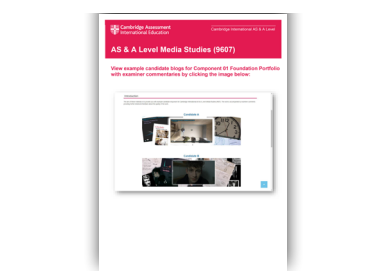
